Welcome to Answering God's call from the inside out Starrette Farm Retreat, Statesville NC

This one-year program includes 5 two-day and 2 one-day retreats for a total of 12 in-person days and monthly virtual short-sessions, that are specifically designed for those who hunger for a holistic approach to the inner work that deepens their life with God as it equips and empowers them to love, live, and lead from their Divine center - wherever God may call, increasingly manifesting the character and power of Christ.

Why The Sacred Invitation?

In a culture competing for the passion of the reaction of our hearts, minds, and souls, and believing that Spirit-led people are the future of the church, *The Sacred Invitation* offers a vision of vocation to create a life of meaning and purpose, described by John Wesley, as doing all the good we can, in all the places we can, for all the people we can, for as long as we can.

How does the program work?

Over the course of the year, students discover their birthright gifts, explore their spiritual journey, read books and articles, view life-changing documentaries, engage monthly in a variety of soul-forming activities, develop a spiritual community with a small group of co-learners, and experience teaching and formational activities built around time-tested concepts. A blend of intellect and experience, individual and community, social justice and contemplation, the program is deeply centered on Christ and rooted in the Gospel. The robust curriculum helps students become more open, receptive, and responsive to God's transforming grace in their lives.

As participants renew their love relationship with the triune God; discover, develop, and use their signature strengths and ground themselves in the vitality of a committed community to share their journey; slowly - over time - spiritual growth takes place. Little by little, participants, like the fern, unfurl the parts once hidden, allowing the creation of a vision of loving service for healing of the world.

Who should apply? If you are experiencing a void in your life that you can't fill with "stuff" from the secular world; if you are called to be a leader in your church but hesitate because you don't feel you have the right "tools"; if you are someone who wants to make a difference in the lives of those marginalized by society; if you are concerned about molding the spiritual lives of those you love; if you are looking to grow your relationship with Jesus in order to grow disciples for Jesus, then The Sacred Invitation journey might be for you.

Retreat Location

Retreats are held at the Starrette Farm Retreat in Statesville, NC. The private sanctuary (est. 1888) spans 25 acres of rolling woodland and walking trails. It is only five minutes from the intersection of I-40 and I-77 on Highway 64 East. The Farm is a "day apart" venue only. Lodging is on your own and not included in retreat cost. Numerous Statesville hotels are only ten minutes



(or less) from the retreat house. Fairfield Inn gives us a deep discount. Sleep Inn gives a discount too. Both are located only 7-minutes from the retreat house.

What are Trust Circles for Group Spiritual Direction?

The purpose of a Trust Circle is the formation of a community of companions and co-listeners for the voice of God in the story of each individual life. We help each other recognize and be more responsive to God's movement and invitations. Trust Circles use the Group Spiritual Direction model (used internationally) created by Rose Mary Dougherty, S.S.N.D. through her work at Shalem Institute for Spiritual Formation. In her book, *Group Spiritual Direction: Community for Discemment*, Sister Rose Mary writes of how her awareness for a "group" spiritual direction experience heightened through her reflection on John Wesley's "class meetings," the Society of Friends' Clearness Committee, and Wesleyan scholar David Watson's model of Covenant Discipleship groups.

LEADERSHIP TEAM



George Stewart is a graduate of School of the Spirit and a two-time graduate of The Sacred Invitation spiritual formation programs. He received his training in Retreat Leadership and Development at Shalem Institute for Spiritual Formation. In 2018, while participating in The Sacred Invitation, he fell in love with God's mission of Starrette Farm Retreat. Since 2020, George has been a steward of Starrette Farm Retreat. His call is leading/facilitating retreats and supporting others while they lead. George attends Clemmons UMC and serves as a Lay Leader.

Nancy Bellamy, The Sacred Invitation program director, has served as steward of Starrette Farm Retreat since 2020. She is an ordained Chaplain, spiritual director, and spiritual formation coach. She is a two-time School of the Spirit alumn and a two-time graduate of The Sacred Invitation. Her degrees in Accounting and IT and studies at Shalem Institute for Spiritual Formation in Spiritual Direction and Group Spiritual Direction has helped her cultivate a business mind within her ministry heart.

Roxanne Morgan oversees our soul food & hospitality service. Through her work as a spiritual director and retreat facilitator, she delights in engaging people through creativity to experience transformation.





Frieda Farfour Brown, Ph.D. is The Sacred Invitation Visionary, advisor, and presenter. Professionally she is a clinical psychologist, a retired university professor, and a program developer within both churches and the community. She is devoted to helping others identify their character strengths and spiritual gifts and discover meaningful ways to use these strengths and gifts in the service of others. She is a two-time graduate of School of the Spirit.

Ann Starrette, a founding Sacred Invitation presenter, oversees the Office of Spiritual Formation & Soul Care, anchored at The Lydia Group, LLC retreat ministry she founded in 1998. She is founding director of School of the Spirit. Ann earned her business degree from UNC-Charlotte and her master's degree in Spiritual Direction and Formation from Richmont Graduate University School of Ministry, Atlanta. Ann sees her role as quietly planting holy seeds that help people reimagine the Divine, unlearn rigid religion, and see God everywhere.



COST AND REGISTRATION

INVESTMENT

For those accepted into the program, generous financial support makes it possible to offer The Sacred Invitation twelve-month experience for only \$950 per student - a substantial saving off the program's cost. In addition to meals, refreshments throughout, instructors, retreat facility, and supplies, our overarching purpose is to provide resources that will sustain pastors, non-profit leaders, and laity in the "long obedience" of their vocational vision.
